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



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APPLICATION STEPS

REVIEW our Transfer Pathways and Course Equivalency Database

APPLY to UWindsor through the OUAC Undergraduate Application, which includes an evaluation fee.

FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS in the acknowledgment email to activate your UWin account, upload transcripts, and complete your To-Do List.

SUBMIT course outlines for those courses you took that have not been previously evaluated.

VIEW transfer credits on your Academic Advising Report or unofficial transcript after you have been activated for registration.

CONNECT with an Academic Advisor for admissions or transfer credit support.

UNIVERSITY STUDENTS

Degree courses will be granted transfer credit where there is a grade of 60% (C-) or better.



COLLEGE STUDENTS

College courses may be granted transfer credit where a grade of 70% or better is achieved, depending on individual course evaluations.
