How to apply?* To apply to the University of Windsor as an international student, the process depends on whether you are an undergraduate or graduate applicant.

- **Undergraduate applicants** can apply directly through the university's portal, via the Ontario Universities' Application Centre (OUAC), or with the help of an authorized educational agent.
- **Graduate applicants** should apply directly to their specific program via the online application system.

Key Requirements:

- **Application submission:** Complete the appropriate online application based on your student status.
- **Documentation:** Upload academic transcripts and diplomas to the UWinsite portal after creating an account. Some programs may also require a portfolio or resume.
- **English proficiency:** Provide proof of English language proficiency through an approved test such as IELTS, TOEFL, or Duolingo.
- **Study permit:** Once accepted, you must apply for a Canadian study permit through the IRCC online portal, which requires an official UWindsor acceptance letter and financial documentation. As of 2024, a Provincial Attestation Letter (PAL) is also required for your study permit application.


